## Hungarian Higher Education Forum in Jakarta

**We kindly invite you to participate in the Hungarian Higher Education Forum organised right before the European Higher Education Fair (EHEF) in Jakarta, Indonesia on 10th and 11th October 2013.**

The event is organised by Tempus Public Foundation (TPF), the Hungarian National Agency of the European education programmes (eg. Erasmus, Erasmus Mundus, Tempus) with the aim of discussing the topics of mobility and joint study programmes as well as the possibility of cooperation and sharing good practises between Hungarian and Indonesian higher education institutions.

Hungarian higher education stands for more than 600 years of academic excellence. Today there are 70 higher education institutions in Hungary ranging from top research universities to minor colleges. Hungary joined the Bologna Process in 1999 by signing the Bologna Declaration with 28 other countries to establish the European Higher Education Area by 2010.

The key objectives of the process are:

- to increase mobility by improving the comparability of the higher educational structures, qualifications and degrees, through developing proper tools for the recognition of periods of studies and degrees,
- to improve employability through the modernization of curricula and
- to strengthen links with the labour market, to enhance the quality of training by developing a scheme of quality assurance.

For these perspectives we would like to foster dialogue and international partnerships between European and Asian higher education institutions and organisations through the Hungarian Higher Education Forum in Jakarta.

As the attached program shows, it is designed to offer plenary sessions, case studies and panel discussions with the active participation of the audience. TPF invited experts from the European and Asian higher education to emphasize the importance of Asian-European, thus Hungarian-Indonesian cooperation in higher education.
